Download our free Mobile Banking Apps designed for your iPad ® iPhone ® or iPod ® Touch and Android ™. If using a BlackBerry ® or Windows ® Phones you may access our Mobile Banking at 4myact.mobi/60261 after signing up for Mobile Banking in the Online Banking System.

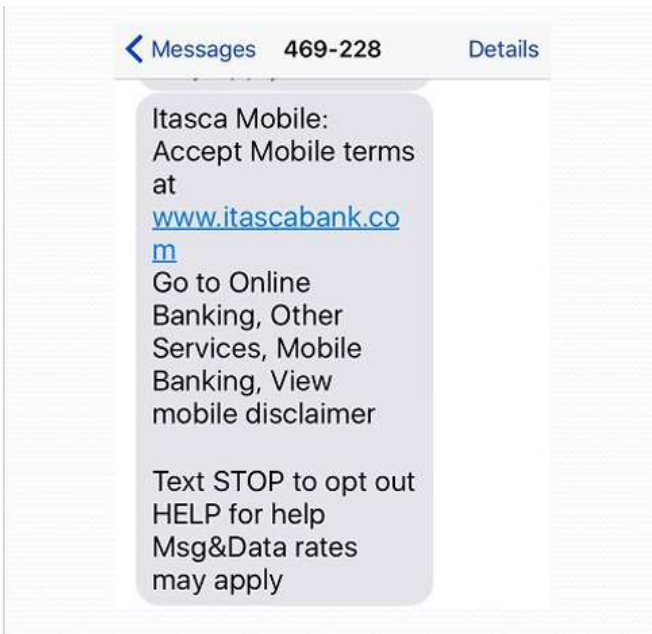
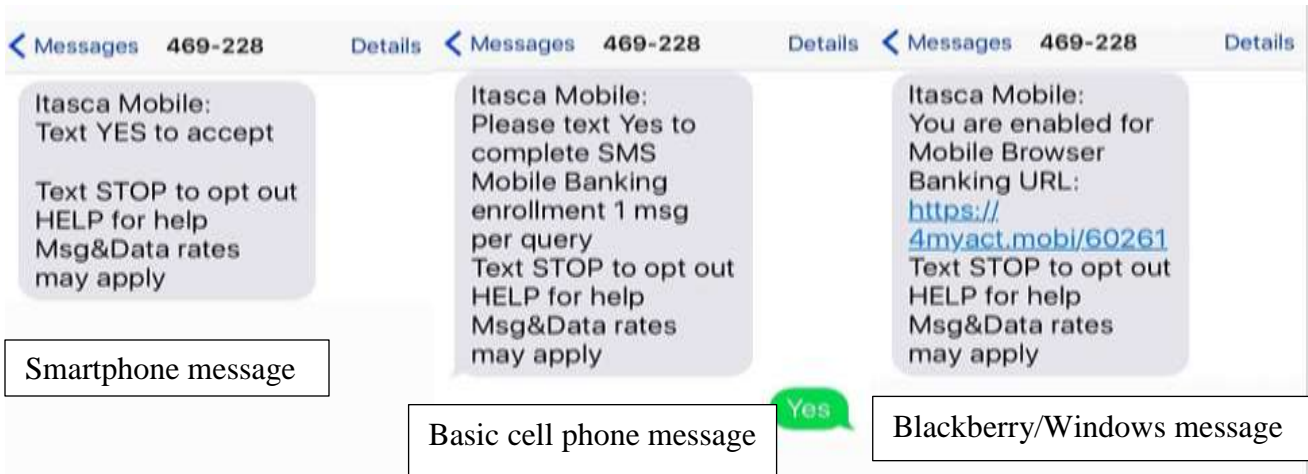
